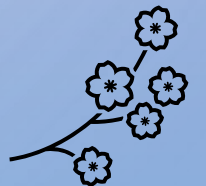

Now we go out to our fellows and repair the damage done in the past. We attempt to sweep away the debris which has accumulated out of our effort to live on self-will and run the show ourselves. If we haven't the will to do this, we ask until it comes. Remember it was agreed at the beginning we would go to any lengths for victory over alcohol."

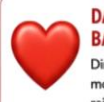

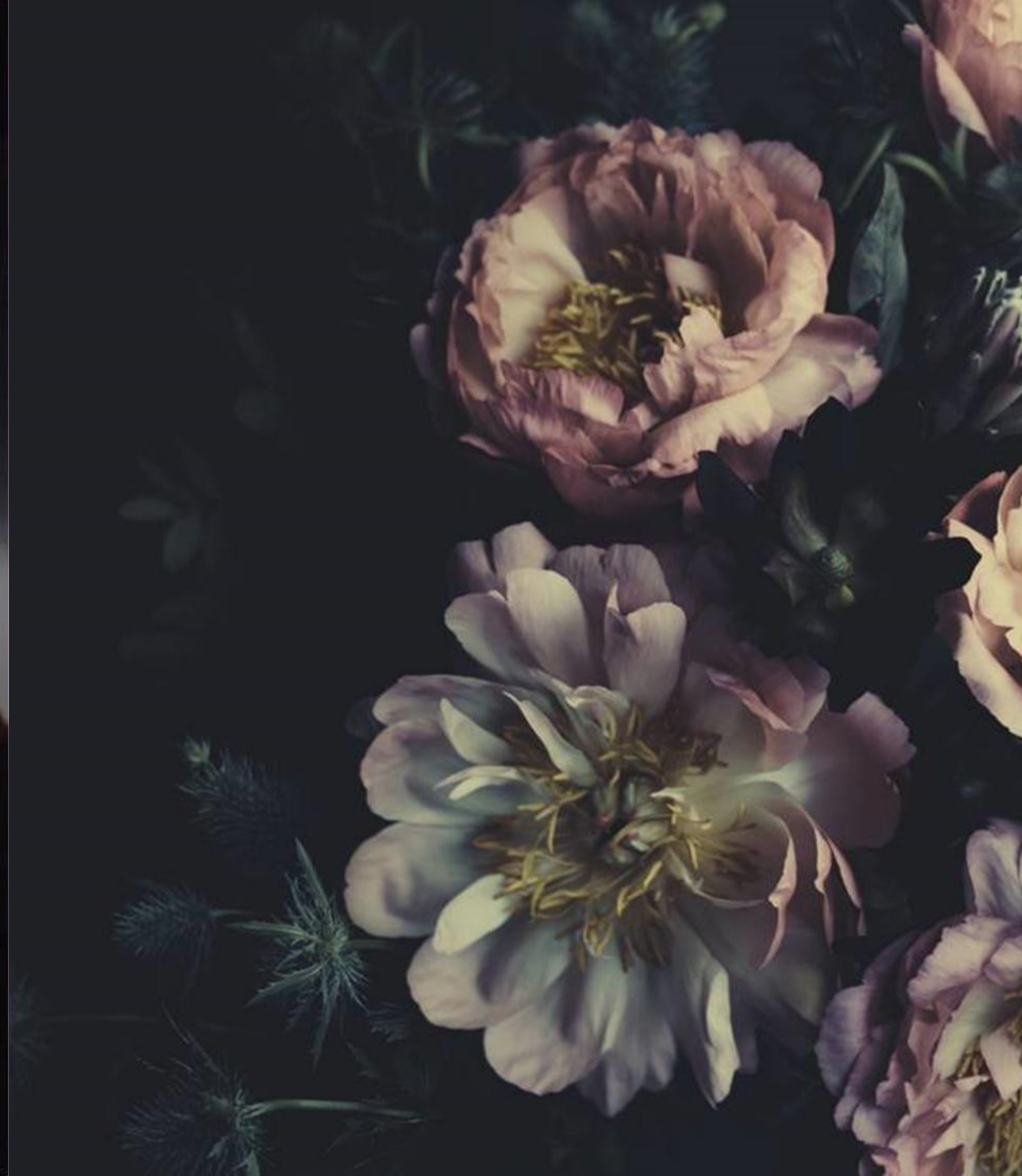

Group Conscience Meeting Minutes June 9, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 6:46 p.m. by Cyarra B., Chairperson, followed by a moment of silence, the Serenity Prayer, reading of the Twelve Traditions, and introductions by attendees.

The following reports were presented:

- Cyarra B. – Chairperson
 - Nothing to report
- Linda R. – Secretary
 - Group reviewed May Group Conscience (GC) minutes.
 - Passed around the email distribution list for changes/corrections.
 - **Motion** made by Cindy M. to accept minutes as presented. Seconded by Benjamin. Approved unanimously without exception.
- Karisa E. – Club 12 Executive Director
 - May contributions totaled \$6,359.18 (In person \$5,365.92; electronically \$1,023.26). Significantly down from past 3-year averages of \$7,800 to \$7,500.
- Jackie M. – Club 12 Board Liaison

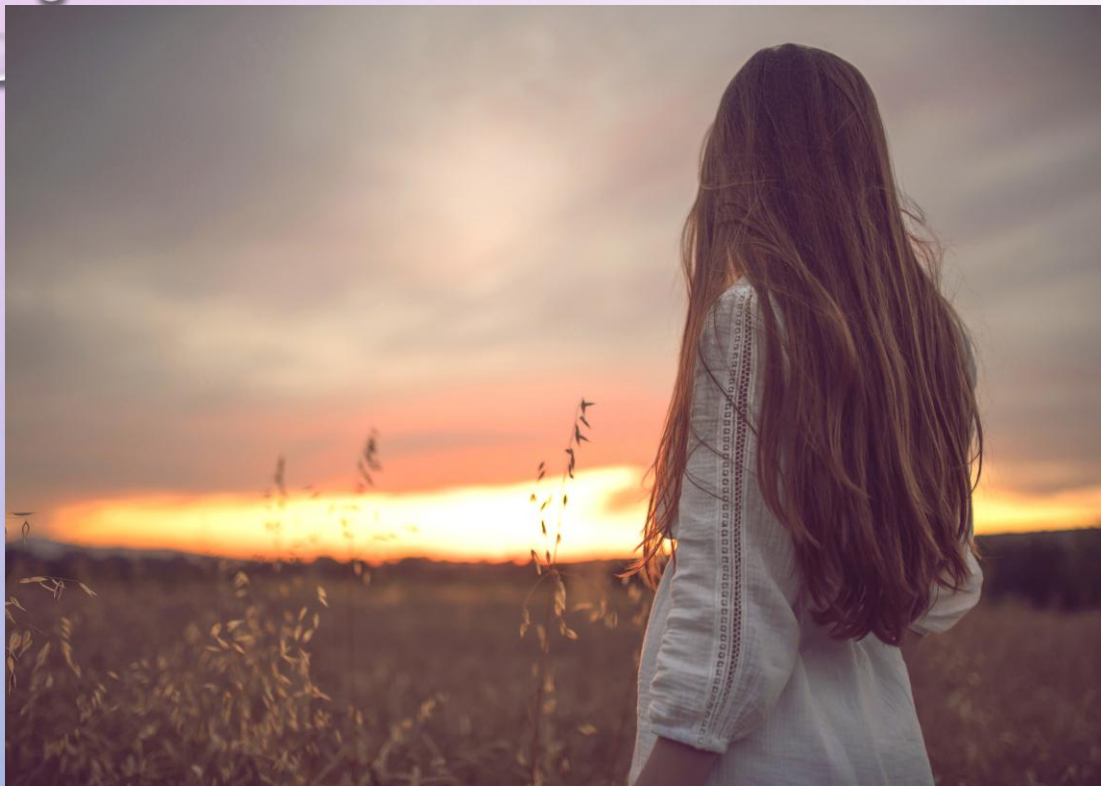
CLUB 12 IS THE FACILITY IN WHICH GROUP 12 MEETS, AND THOSE PEOPLE WHO OPERATE
